Watch the downtown Toledo fireworks from aboard the Schoonmaker.

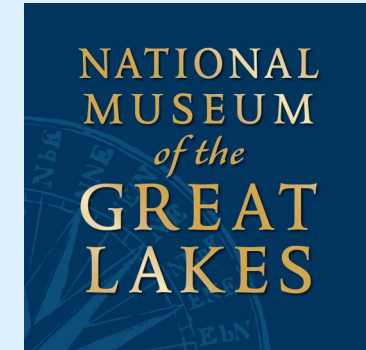
### Boo on the Boat

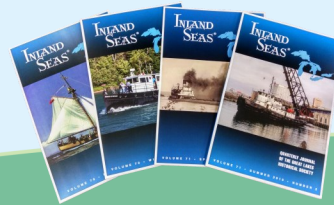
